Some notes from Keith Jenkins' teaching.

Bassenfell, March 2014.

As you read through these notes please pray that by God's grace the Holy Spirit will lead you into truth that will change your relationship with our Heavenly Father, for the better.

Getting to the root of our problems

- The root of all our problems is a lack of the love of God in our own lives.
- The purpose of the Church (the salt of the earth) is to keep the world aware of the love of God.
- Paul (the chief of all sinners) knew the love of God and promoted it. He was crucified to the world. He would die for anyone. He would give all he had for anyone.
- The church only seems to have the love of the world rather than the abundance of the love of God that it should have.
- If you cannot love your wife, you cannot love anyone else.
- When you compare yourself to others you will come to the wrong conclusion.
- If you want to become more spiritual then you have to repent. There is no other way. II Peter 3:9. You only have as long as God allows.
- Repentance starts with looking at your sin. Then asking why you did it. As you do this under the leading of the Spirit, Godly sorrow will begin to grow.
- You can only process Godly sorrow the right way if you know the love of God.
- II Corinthians 7:10. Godly sorrow brings repentance that leads to life. Worldly sorrow leads to death.
- The world is dying due to a lack of love. (In many cases the Church is dying due to a lack of love!)
- Why do something out of fear rather than out of love. If you do this then this is a sign that you are spiritually sick.
- You will get God's assistance to be used by Him at the level you are at but this does not make you any more spiritual.
- God only gives us commands that are appropriate to our level of spiritual maturity. He does not 'test us' beyond what we are able to endure.
- When we fall short on keeping His commands it is because we are trying to do what He says in the flesh.
- Keeping God's commands is the way we build up something that has eternal value. God wants us to build up treasures in heaven and so gives us commands BUT we choose how we are going to go about obeying Him. This should be in the Spirit but is more often in the flesh!
- You cannot keep on giving of yourself to others without causing some damage to yourself. The only way to give love is to give of the love of God because you, yourself, have an abundant supply.
- The desire (both in the world and in the church) for 'thrills and spills' is a sign of the lack of the love of God.
- Why would anyone look for love outside of the Church?
- Matthew 25:8&9 Foolish people always run to others for help rather than going to the right place. This is about paying the price for acquiring the level of love that you want. **The first condition is that Jesus is the functional Lord of your life.)**
- There is only one rule in the Kingdom of God....**Do what He says!** If you do not keep this one rule then you are denying the whole of scripture!

- If you really believe that God loves you then you will do everything He wants. You would never run the risk of getting it wrong. You would seek Him in every situation.
- Revelation 2:1-5. (Church at Ephesus...note. This is about the church not the world!) A 'perfect' church except for one thing – they did not have the love of God. Because of this God said He would remove the candlestick. If God does this then it means He will no longer use you or exalt you. You will lose any anointing that you have. **God must be your first love!** Make the decision to listen to what God is actually saying to you and stop trying to justify using your own reasoning and understanding.
- We cannot live by principles but rather by the Word of God. He must be Lord.
- The foundation of our life should be that Jesus is Lord and our first love. We should do just as we are told just like Jesus did.
- John 2:5 Mary said "Whatever He says to you, do it!" (We should be the same!)
- Philippians 2:12&13. Work out your own salvation in the strength of God. (We do not have His strength or permission to do things in the flesh!)
- Romans 10:4 For Christ is the end of the law...If you believe He is the end of the law then you will do whatever He tells you to do. However, we tend to 'rustle the pages' to find a way of justifying not allowing Him to be the end of the law as far as our righteousness is concerned. Righteousness is given to us by the Spirit but we would rather operate through works.
- There is no longer any law but if you are hanging on to your own doctrine and principles then you are not accepting that Jesus is the end of the law!
- Accepting Jesus as the end of the law means accepting His verdict of everything we do or think of doing.
- I John 1:4. "Writing so that your joy may be full." Verse 6 If we say we have fellowship with Him and then walk in our own reasoning and understanding then we lie.
- The letter of the law kills.
- We are free to do whatever God says!
- Verse 7. If we walk in the light...this means that we are dealing with the things He tells us. This further means that the things (sin) we are not dealing with are covered by the blood until He requires us to deal with it.
- What others are doing is none of our business unless clearly directed by God to get involved. We have no authority of ourselves to do anything other than what God says!
- If two are in the light then they can have fellowship. We do not have time to look at the sin of others.
- Get back to Jesus being the functional Lord of your life.
- Live in the Light. Put on the armour of Light. Romans 13:12
- Fall in love with God. I John 2:8
- Love your brother. I John 4:21
- Love worketh not ill of its neighbour. Romans 13:10
- Clothe yourself with the love of the Lord Jesus. Romans 13:14. ie. Put on and operate in His love, His light. Put on the armour of light.
- Submit to God. James 4:17. If authority is not given to us by Jesus then we have none. (Be careful not to take the authority, He has specifically given to others, for yourself.)
- Submit to those who do the work of the Ministry, those

Report on Ministry Visit to Scandinavia and Russia, in May 2014

On this trip in May I had a meeting in Paris on Sunday afternoon but it was just possible to also visit Riom on the Saturday evening. The Baptist church there gave me time to speak for nearly two hours. The people were blessed with the message. In Paris also the people there were ready for a message of repentance. The pastor in Paris was keen for all his people to study what they heard so the church split up into smaller groups so they could study and read through the scriptures I had referred to. I spoke on 2 Peter 1:1-10 and 2 Peter 3:8-10. I had to leave before the end of the service and travel by metro and then by bus to the airport at Beauvais. I was to fly to Norway and then to Finland. I stopped overnight in Oslo with one pastor and we had time to share and catch up even though we did not have much time together. He also helped me to travel between the two airports with an airport bus. I arrived on time despite some long queues at the airport security.

In Helsinki, two chapter meetings of the Full Gospel Businessmen's Fellowship International hosted me. These two meetings were to be a catalyst for many other meetings. In the first meeting I spoke and several bought books. Two persons particularly asked where else I was speaking and wanted to arrange something for me if I was coming back. I explained I was going to Russia but coming back on Friday! Normally I have a meeting every night when I am travelling but on this date I had no meeting which was unusual. Despite contacting many pastors there was no-one with a regular Friday evening meeting. They were very keen to hear more so one person at the meeting arranged to fill up my free day. On the Tuesday night meeting (a year before) one brother told me about the Ferry going to St Petersburg from Finland and gave me a church contact there. In Finland generally people do not smile unless you tell a joke. But especially when there is a lot of conviction their faces can seem motionless as they concentrate!

I met one pastor during the day and Wednesday evening I travelled overnight by boat to Russia! This was my first time here. A Ferry company, that included the Russian Visa in their costs, operated the sailing so this was easy. I had an afternoon meeting in St Petersburg. When I arrived at 7am, I got the bus provided to Isaac Square where someone was going to meet me. I prayed and asked the Lord if I should use the bus or just wait for someone to meet me where the Ferry arrived. I had told the church contact I would meet them in Isaac square. In Russia, every movement is watched and registration with the Police is compulsory. Therefore I wanted to acknowledge the Lord in all things. (I had not done this before when I worked with the underground church before joining SOLM.) On the ferry company website their port bus for customers indicated four dropping off places for their bus service from the port. I felt the Lord said I should use bus dropping point no. 4, which seemed to be at the end of the line at Isaac Square. It seemed I would be on the bus for an hour, especially in the morning traffic. However, the bus driver dropped everyone there first! Dropping point no. 4 was the nearest location to the meeting place! While I was waiting I was directed by the Lord to a nearby hotel and sat in the lobby. The hotel had free internet where I was able to catch up

Ivory Coast

My English is not very fine. So don't take care for mistakes or bad words. I have a message for you; so I try to do my best.

Do you remember when recently you came to Cote d'Ivoire to meet Pastor Bangoret. Someone named 'Paques' (Easter in English) came to you. It is me. I bought one of your books and you have dedicated it. I told you that I had a testimony about your arrival at Pastor Bangoret church named Elkabod.

Here is this Testimony: God told me on several months to obey to Him at any case (all occasions); but I didn't because I have no power to do this. Sometimes He tells me to fast for several days, or he sends me somewhere to give an important message to someone. I know that He wants to lead me but I resist.

I live in a small town named Bonoua not very far from Abidjan. This Sunday (when you came to the church), God told me clearly that He leads me to Elkabod (Pastor Bangoret's church) for something special. What thing? I don't know. I could go to my church in Bonoua, or somewhere else. But God says "Go to, Bangoret's Church". So I decided to go there. I tell to Holy Spirit I am very late to go there. He says to me "I send you there, not for the praise (note: the service begins by praise), but for something else." I am perplexed (confused). What to do? I obey and go to that church. Then, when I saw you standing for preaching, God says to me clearly, "I sent this man from so far because of you. He will tell you what you have to do. So you will trust (to) me forever." Your message is exactly what I needed. Your presence convinced me that you are sent to Cote d'Ivoire, for me specially. You are really man of God. Pursue your beautiful ministry with no doubt; you are in the truth. God bless you. (I can say more, but I am short in English).

on my regular emails while I waited. I only had six books for the meeting in St Petersburg in Russian. These disappeared quickly at the afternoon meeting and the translator was also keen to buy a copy. I just had enough time to get on the ferry which left early on its way back to Helsinki.

The FGB were so touched by the message on the Monday evening that they arranged a follow up meeting and contacted over 100 people in just two days. About 20 people came to a small hall and the place was full of excited faces on the Friday. The meeting in Helsinki finished very late and I had only three hours sleep that night. I just lay on top of the bed and God gave me supernatural rest. At 5am I caught the bus to the airport and travelled to Latvia and then to Sweden. The airline was having some complications and I had to print boarding passes the day before in Helsinki. In Riga I spoke for only two sessions at a small church but the translator was very happy to see me again after last year. She offered to help with translating all of Joseph's books into Russian!

In Stockholm I finally got some rest and the next day had three sessions including questions and answers. Then, in the evening, I went to another church and met the senior Pastor. He was touched by the message and was open for another visit next year. From Stockholm I went, by bus, to Norway overnight. I had two meetings that day and then another evening meeting on the Tuesday in the area around Tonsberg. The message again focused on repentance but the people were happy to hear a strong message. While I was there Haakon, my host, had pulled some muscles in his arm the night before. This meant he collected me at the airport and then explained that he was not able to go to work. As a result of this we had time together and worked on some of the messages he had heard me share!

My last country on this short trip was Poland. I flew into Warsaw to meet one pastor and then at a MacDonalds near the airport we all met and the brother from Lodz took me to his place. I spoke over three days to several churches. During that time, over 100 Polish books were sold or paid for. The people were blessed by the teaching. Even one of their prophets came to attend the sessions to learn. An ex-government official, who turned to Christ, had arranged all this. He just read the book, "My Sheep Hear My Voice" and decided to arrange a meeting for my visit and started speaking to all his friends. This man reached out to nearly 50 of his friends and church contacts and they all wanted to hear more!! The name of the church that hosted my visit was called "The Church of the Second Chance".

This was one of the most effective trips to Scandinavia. From this trip I also got an urgent invite to go back in June 2014.

Report on Trip to Eastern Europe April 2014

Every year I travel to Eastern Europe and this year this began with a meeting in Paris on Sunday where I was able to speak in the morning at an African Congregation. After the service one other church joined us for a meal. I was planning to make my way by train so I had to go to the centre of Paris. However, one couple took me to Gare du Nord train station afterwards but they were French speaking. They were asking for the French version of the book. We had to make conversation with sign language and simple English words!

From Paris I travelled by train to Cologne and this gave me some time to work on my emails. I had internet access on the train. At a time like this I ask the Lord if it is a time for rest or a time for work! The train arrived on time and Simon Luke was there to meet me. I was able to even chat via the internet as the train was slightly delayed. I stayed overnight with Simon and then the next day we had a session from 10am to 1pm. Immediately after this time I was scheduled to fly to Georgia overnight and then by bus to Yerevan. I stayed with one of the leaders of New Life. When I arrived at noon with his young people I had one meeting with his staff and then met the leader of another large ministry there. The next day I travelled by bus back to Georgia in the morning and then to the airport where I flew to Vienna. I spoke in Graz that night in a church where the Pastor was from Romania. He could see the need in Austria to have some solid teaching so his response was very positive to the message afterwards. He immediately asked for a date next year in April for a seminar. From Graz I travelled over the boarder into Hungary and there spoke in a reformed church. The leader had contacted a number of people and church was full. The message was well received and afterwards I had to get the overnight train to Arad in Romania leaving at Midnight. The train arrived at 5am and from there I was collected by car. I only managed to have a few hours sleep on the train so when I arrived I got a few hours rest and I had to be up at 8am. Then the Seminar was arranged from 10:00 – 13:00 for a Brethren church. They were very grateful for the message and next year wanted a whole weekend. The message mainly focussed on repentance but they also helped me with the train fare and an offering. The brother from Arad brought me back to Arad train station so that I could travel to Satu Mare by the evening and catch up with my programme there.

On Sunday morning I spoke in a church of nearly 200 and in the evening at one of the largest Pentecostal churches in the country in Baia Mare of about 500. The host Pastor was not present in the evening but the elders were there to receive me. The elder leading the service really liked the message. That day he did not have a translator because the pastor was not present. He wanted to get someone really fast and he was praying what to do. He left his car in the car park and God told him to go outside and that he would meet the right person. He was planning to visit another church in the evening and God said go. While he was visiting he heard a young man translating for another visitor and it was very clear and he was also available to translate me on Sunday evening. This was a good example of hearing the Lord so the elder was blessed to hear that this is the way we should be living. Afterwards we had a meal together and returned to Satu Mare before travelling the next day to Timisoara by bus.

In Timisoara I spoke in one of the largest Charismatic churches and to the young people. The message was about "The Love of God". Several brought copies of the books, My Sheep Hear My Voice and How Love Grows in Romanian. Now, again, I travelled by train back to Hungary. I had to travel for about 6 hours with two changes. I was invited by one of the leaders of the Reformed churches in Hungary, who personally translated for me. This invite came because of a Hungarian lady in Germany,

who was from that area, made some telephone calls seeking a church that was available that evening with a meeting where I could preach! This was the only day I had free on my schedule. The message was well received and I was invited to come back again. I was able to get a train from the place where I was staying in the morning and God told me to get off at Kobany Kispest. From this station I was then able to catch a bus direct to the airport. I also was able to change what money I had into USA dollars at a very good rate. I had not planned it like this but the lady of place where I was staying also gave me a bus ticket for this type of bus to the airport. Only God knew all this I only obeyed and changed at this train station. Everything worked perfectly allowing me to catch my flight, which was on time. Also the rates of exchange at the train station were much better than at the airport! God knows all these things!

I arrived in Eindhoven airport on time. It was not far for me to go but there was a bit of traffic. Bert Spaans was assisting me and missed a turning on the motorway when he was coming to collect me. I prayed and just asked the Lord where to stand so that he would see and this helped. I was also able to work on a few of my emails at the church before the meeting and we arrived in time for the meeting. I took some copies of the "Wake Up Time is Running Out". The book "My Sheep Hear My Voice" has been translated into Dutch as well and the people were keen to buy after hearing the message. I stayed one night in Maastricht with Bert and then the next day we travelled together to the Pastor's house in Vervier. This was a new house and we had some time here before the meeting and travelling to Spa to meet another Pastor. The meeting was from 2-4pm with time for questions but afterwards this gave me enough time to reach Charleroi Airport where I took a flight to Manchester. The trip covered nine countries in about two weeks.

Report on Trip to Corsica, Finland and Denmark and London in June 2014

This was a short trip but with a lot of flights. I had agreed to go to Corsica and found a flight to go there on Wednesday 4th June. This was a gathering of about four churches and I stayed just a few hours in Calvi. My host had to drive and collect me each time from the airport in Bastia about 90 minutes away. This meant they were driving a total of six hours, but they were very happy to do this even on windy roads. The meeting was in a Protestant church and the people were excited at this possibility. The message was about 'Getting to Know God through Repentance and Living in His presence'. Afterwards quite a few bought books and I also left some books for the German speaking people there. My next meeting was to be in Helsinki after travelling through Paris. All the flights were over £400 but the Lord reminded me I had some airmiles and this helped make a considerable reduction on the cost. The Lord directed me to book the flight with BA from Paris Orly. It was scheduled to arrive at 4pm, two hours before the meeting. The flight into Air Corsica left at 6am and then I had two hours between flights in Paris Orly. Thankfully, it was on time! In London I had only 90 minutes but one of the aircraft requested assistance and they closed one of the runways as a precaution. I just made it to the gate in time to find the flight was delayed by 2 hours. The aircraft was replaced and arrived in Helsinki at 7pm. The meeting was supposed to start at 6pm. I eventually arrived 2 hours late and had been travelling since 2am. I eventually got to bed at 1am. This was approximately 22 hours on the go. I was tired!

The meeting in Helsinki had been requested after my last trip there in May and the people who originally heard were very hungry to hear more of the message. They pressed me to come and when I arrived, despite my lateness they were ready. Some had come early and one man spoke loudly saying "I have been waiting for 2 hours. I hope this is worth it!" He was sitting in front of me and was anxious for the meeting to start. I responded by saying that I would be happy to make the message extra challenging just specially for him. He responded with a smile. Afterwards he greeted me and thanked me saying that the message was very clear and was what he needed to hear. No one left the building until 10pm and, even then, several stayed and asked questions until Midnight. This group were not able to house me so I requested that the church hosted me on Friday and I stayed with a Nigerian brother who had a Cypriot wife living in Helsinki.

On Friday I spoke at the DEI radio station at 2pm in Helsinki. Before that I met a brother from an Independent Christian School at 11am and then also had some time to change some Euros and get some lunch. The Lord ensured that all the meetings and appointments worked somehow and then I had a meeting at 4pm during the afternoon. The church was small but the people asked many questions. One of the pastors from a nearby church came as well. The couple I stayed with continued to ask me questions about the message and were also hungry for truth.

On Saturday morning I had a very early flight from the airport so I had to get a taxi and fly to Copenhagen. I had not spoken there for such a long time and I was looking forward to being there. I arrived to find the Lady pastor had the flu and could not come to the meeting. Instead her husband came to collect me. He was not sure who I was at first but then as I began to share my testimony his heart was touched and he shared that the message was much needed. The whole church had gone through a difficult time and realised they needed to make a fresh start. Several had felt that the Lord was going to make this fresh start following my visit. They had rented a premises for the meeting which was they had been meeting before. A few of the people had some doubts about the teaching but were able to get their questions answered. The husband of the pastor wanted to start the SOLM correspondence course and was keen to start immediately!

This was a great trip and I felt that those arranging and hosting my meetings all went to great lengths to get this message to their own nation. This made all the meetings possible and was also a great encouragement to me as some pastors can often feel intimidated by a very strong message and can be jealous of the international traveller and not want to help. The pastors can sometimes act as if they did a favour arranging the meeting for me. This was not the case here and I felt so much was achieved. Even though the meetings were not large they reached many different people from different backgrounds.

Early morning I had to get a flight to Gatwick, London to be there for a meeting on Sunday morning. The flight was delayed and also when I came out of the airport the flow of passengers was very heavy. In the confusion I made a small detour and this meant

I ended up delayed and had to spend some extra time getting my train ticket at the automatic machines. Despite this I asked the station master if I could travel on the next train and I still arrived on time. I then had to take a bus and managed to just have enough strength to get to the church on time. I had some books left from the trip and my bag had lost a wheel so this had also delayed me getting to the train station. The Holy Nation church was meeting at 10:30 am near Westminster Abbey. As I reached the door the assistant pastor was there and he had a trolley to help my suitcase up in the lift to the second floor where the church was meeting. My messages on the trip mainly focussed on 'Repentance' and 'How to Live Under Grace'. God is so good!

Testimony

USA

Two Saturdays ago, I sat down with the Lord, just broken over our finances. I asked Him what the problem was. He brought to mind what you had emailed before when I had asked this same question. You had said I was judging myself, as well as thinking too much. You also said to meditate on the Scriptures on forgiveness. (As a side note, He led through some deeper repentance on 'thinking too much' think recently as well!) I wasn't aware of judging myself, having repented of that before, but since He brought it to mind, I started praying by faith in that direction. The Holy Spirit took over. I'm not sure exactly what He was doing, but I was crying and felt a deep contrition over my sin. At the same time of seeing my sin, I forgave myself for it and also repented of any judgments that I had made thinking that the Lord was judging me....I was crying to the Lord to forgive me...then the Lord lifted this weight off of me. It just lifted, like that. And I knew I was forgiven. It really felt like just getting saved all over again. I don't really understand it, but when I go to the Word now, the blocks that were there before have been removed. It's like, He is speaking it right to me. I can believe that it is for me, speaking to me, and there is a reality in it.

Just a couple of days ago, as I read Romans, the Holy Spirit began witnessing to a couple of Scriptures in it. "Who was delivered for our offences, and was raised again for our justification" and "Therefore, being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ." (Rom 4:25, 5:1) This time, I felt His witness like goose bumps. Each time I would go back to it, He would witness again. I thought, "Lord, so I have peace with You?" and He witnessed again!

It is so funny that you emailed because the Lord just did something a couple of weeks ago where He used your previous email. After what I last wrote, I wasn't able to get the witness of the Spirit working reliably. I do spend time with the Lord asking Him to show me anything that hinders fellowship with Him and allow Him to lead me through repentance. That is normal for me. I've probably done that regularly for three years now. He has led through repentance after repentance. (I had been a prodigal and there was a lot of junk to clean up.) But it still was blocked. Recently He laid it on my heart that I really need to make it a priority to just get this working because I need to be able to test things and I want to obey His commands. And I want to know Him.

An exciting beginning! Praise God! I can't tell you how much I have wanted communication and relationship with Him. I want Him to be Lord and take over my life – He is welcome to lead it any way He wants...but I need to hear Him to know what to obey.

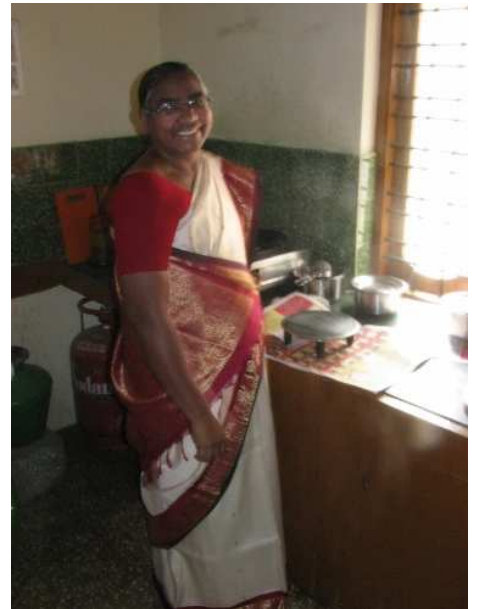
There had also been a block with Jesus...it kind of felt like a condemnation. Even with seeking and seeking, time in the Word, prayer, worship....I couldn't get past that. But since He did this two Saturdays ago, it has been removed. Praise You, Jesus. When I see "forgiveness of sin" in the Word, it is extremely precious to me. It has become real. Praise You, Lord, for Your blood and Your righteousness.

I know all of this sounds incredibly basic, like something a new Christian should just experience, but for some reason, it has only come to me by much persistence. Now is a time to be renewed in the Word of God.

I thank the Lord for speaking to you, and I welcome anything else that He says to you! The words that the Lord spoke to you were spot on. Any correction is most welcome. I can't tell you how much I appreciate it!

Our Amaryllis



Although it flowered the first year we had it, this plant of ours has not had a very happy existence. In fact, I had thought it was dead and, last autumn, had left it in a pot in the garden. Much to my surprise, a month ago I noticed that there was a green shoot coming from it. Upon looking more closely, I realised that there were two shoots. The plant that was dead was very much alive. I decided to put it on the patio with some hedging plants we had bought knowing that I would water all of them on a regular basis. A week ago I noticed that some of the leaves had been nibbled. The day after I

noticed that they had been nibbled some more. I realised that I needed to deal with the slugs before the plant that had struggled to stay alive was well and truly finished off for good. Today, about five days on there is not a lot left of the amaryllis. It is dying and the reason is my failure to act! I have, at last, just gone and found a way of dealing with the slugs.

Of course, the Lord had something to say about this! He pointed out to me that so many of His children treat themselves in exactly the same way. They become aware that there is a problem. They become aware of what have to do to deal with it. However, they keep putting it off and this results in the potential damage becoming greater. He is the one who brings our needs to our attention and the remedy that we need to apply. **When we do not respond we are ignoring Him!** In our own reasoning and understanding, tomorrow is always soon enough. In God's timing, the day He brings something to our attention is the day He wants us to respond. How sad it is that we so often choose to please our flesh instead of responding to God. Like the amaryllis we can be dying (spiritually) and the reason is our failure to act the way the Father has revealed to us.

Is there something the Father has laid on your heart that you are not dealing with in a responsible manner. If so, don't let it get any worse!!

A modern day parable

The man recognised the sound he could hear as he ate his breakfast. The heavy chugging of the engine clearly meant that the neighbour's car was not going to start. The man knew that his neighbour had a regular routine and that he was going to be late for work unless a quick solution was found. The man was a good man, a Christian who took his faith seriously. He wore the WWJD (What would Jesus do) bracelet both as a witness to his Saviour and also as a reminder to himself that he was responsible for representing Jesus at all times. He did not take long to decide what to do. He knew it was his responsibility to help his neighbour and, without giving it a second thought he left his breakfast and went to help. Twenty minutes later, problem solved, he happily returned to cold tea and toast pleased that he had been able to help.

The man had followed a procedure that most of God's children use. He knew it was his responsibility to help, to put others first and to be a good witness. He had done what he believed to be right but through it all had used his own reasoning and understanding of the situation and made the decision to act the way he did. It all seemed right and it had turned out all right, or so it seemed at the time. The problem the man had was that he had relied on his own reasoning and understanding and had not checked with the Lord if he should act the way he decided.

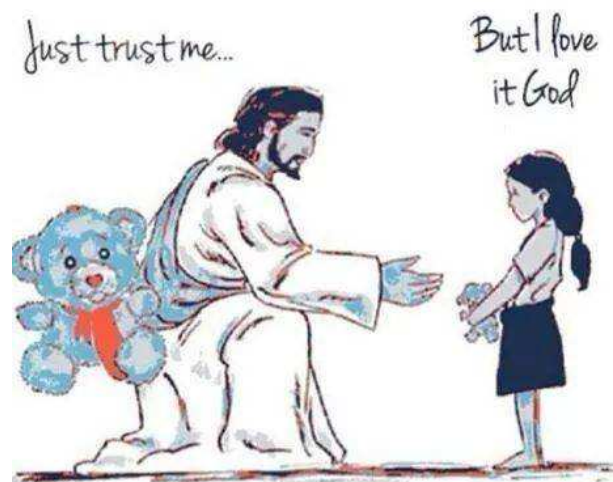
Whilst the man was helping the neighbour the phone was ringing in the house. The phone eventually went dead because there was no-one there to



answer it. It was the man's mother and she was having a heart attack and had turned to her son for help. Had he been there he would have been able to respond the way she needed. As it was, through his good intentions, he had made himself unavailable at the very time she needed him.

The lord knows so much more than we do and when we fail to acknowledge Him the way we should (see Proverbs 3 vs 5&6) we take all kinds of risks that he does not intend for us. Had the man acknowledged the lord, the Lord would have told him to continue eating His breakfast knowing that he would be needed by the phone for his mother!

Whenever we **rely on our own knowledge, experience or logic and make decisions based upon our conclusions** we are living contrary to the Word of God. There is no scripture that contradicts Proverbs 3; 5&6. If we come to a conclusion that is contrary to it, then we are believing a lie that is not from the Word of God!

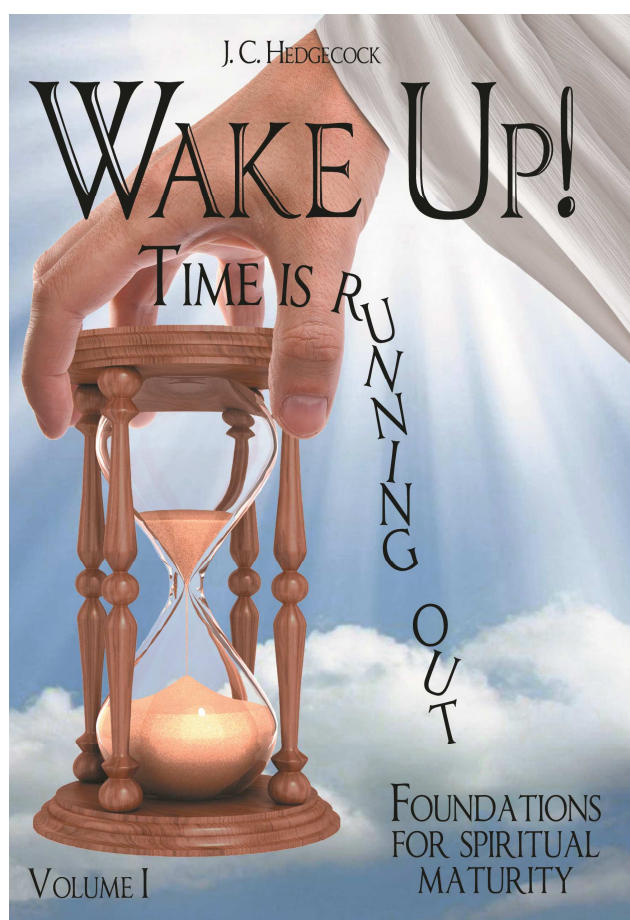
