Thousands of immigrants were coming from Europe every year because they had no jobs or land in their homes. They had little money and often lived in poor-**crowded** cities and buildings. Many of immigrants had come from small villages. They didn't know how to live in big cities. Many of them didn't speak English and they didn't have job skills. In 1889 two upper-class women, Jane Addams and Ellen Gates Starr, moved into a big house in a poor **neighbourhood** of Chicago. They called it "Hull House". With others help, at night they gave classes in English language and job skills for factory workers. They also opened a kindergarten for small children whose parents worked in factories. They had clubs for older children and a library. They helped 2.000 people every week to have healthier and better lives. Today in Chicago, the Hull House Association continues the social work that was begun by Jane Addams more than a century ago.
