CONVERGENCE ANGLE OF 0°35'58" TO
STATE PLANE COORDINATES AS DETERMINED
BY G.P.S. METHODS.

NOTE:

RESURVEYS OF ORIGINAL BENSON/GLOVER SURVEYS IN OTHER TOWNSHIPS SHOW THAT SIGNIFICANT MEASUREMENT ERROR IS TO BE EXPECTED. 1931 AND 1941 RESURVEYS OF T9N R22E (WILSON/JOHNSTON), IMMEDIATELY NORTH OF THIS SURVEY, FOUND BENSON/GLOVER MEASUREMENTS TO VARY BY AS MUCH AS 8 CHAINS IN 40. LOCAL BLM SURVEYOR BELIEVES BENSON/GLOVER RAN EAST TO WEST ONLY, WITH SIDE LEGS TO SET W 1/4 CORNERS. SUCH A METHOD IS CONSISTANT WITH FOUND VARIATION OF 2" IN EAST-WEST LINES AND 10" IN NORTH-SOUTH LINES.
