Romans 1:17, NKJV – (17) ... as it is written, "THE JUST SHALL LIVE BY FAITH."

How do the just live? They live by _____.

Romans 1:21, NKJV – (21) because, although they knew God, they did not glorify Him as God, nor were thankful, but became futile in their thoughts, and their foolish hearts were darkened.

Four progressive steps that people take away from God (and His benefits).

1. They did not _____ (value/esteem/prize) God as God.

So we must Put the proper value on God.

2. They were not _____ (magnifying what God has done).

So we must Be thankful.

3. They became vain (futile) in their _____ (imagination).

So we must Have a positive imagination (which produces hope – Romans 5:5).

4. Their foolish heart was _____.

So we must Keep our heart from being darkened.

Ephesians 4:17-18, NKJV – (17) *This I say, therefore, and testify in the Lord, that you should no longer walk as the rest of the Gentiles walk, in the futility of their mind, (18) having their understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God, because of the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart;*

When you walk in the futility of your mind, your understanding will become _____ and you will be _____ from the life of God.

Exodus 14:8, NKJV – (8) *And the LORD hardened the heart of Pharaoh king of Egypt, and he pursued the children of Israel; and the children of Israel went out with boldness.*

Pharoah continued to pursue the children of Israel because his heart was _____.

Exodus 14:20, NKJV – (19) *And the Angel of God, who went before the camp of Israel, moved and went behind them; and the pillar of cloud went from before them and stood behind them. (20) So it came between the camp of the Egyptians and the camp of Israel. Thus it was a cloud and darkness to the one, and it gave light by night to the other, so that the one did not come near the other all that night.*

The pillar of cloud gave light to the Israelites, but _____ to the Egyptians.

Mark 6:51-52, NIV – (51) *Then He went up into the boat to them, and the wind ceased. And they were greatly amazed in themselves beyond measure, and marveled. (52) For they had not understood about the loaves, because their heart was hardened.*
